### Artist Collective Membership Requirements

- \$120 annual fee (includes CIAS membership)
- Volunteer time:
  - Minimum 2 shifts per month (shifts are 3-4hrs)
  - 3 shifts on month when your art is on display\*\*
  - Shifts may be filled by another member who has met the Artist Collective requirements, but you must sign up for the minimum number of shifts each month and are responsible for filling them
- Art must pass jury criteria to be displayed
- Display fee \$25 per month due 1st of month prior to art going on display (except Gift Shop items)\*
- Sales Fee: 20% commission
- Completion of sales training session provided by CIAS within 2 months of registration
- Submission of Criminal Record Check to the Gallery Director within 2 months of registration
- Submission of artist statement and biography (for use in promotional material, gallery displays, website, etc.) by the 1st of the month prior to art being displayed

\*10% discount on display fee for members of non-profit groups that have current CIAS Group membership

\*\* Number of shifts will vary with available display space and number of submitting members
